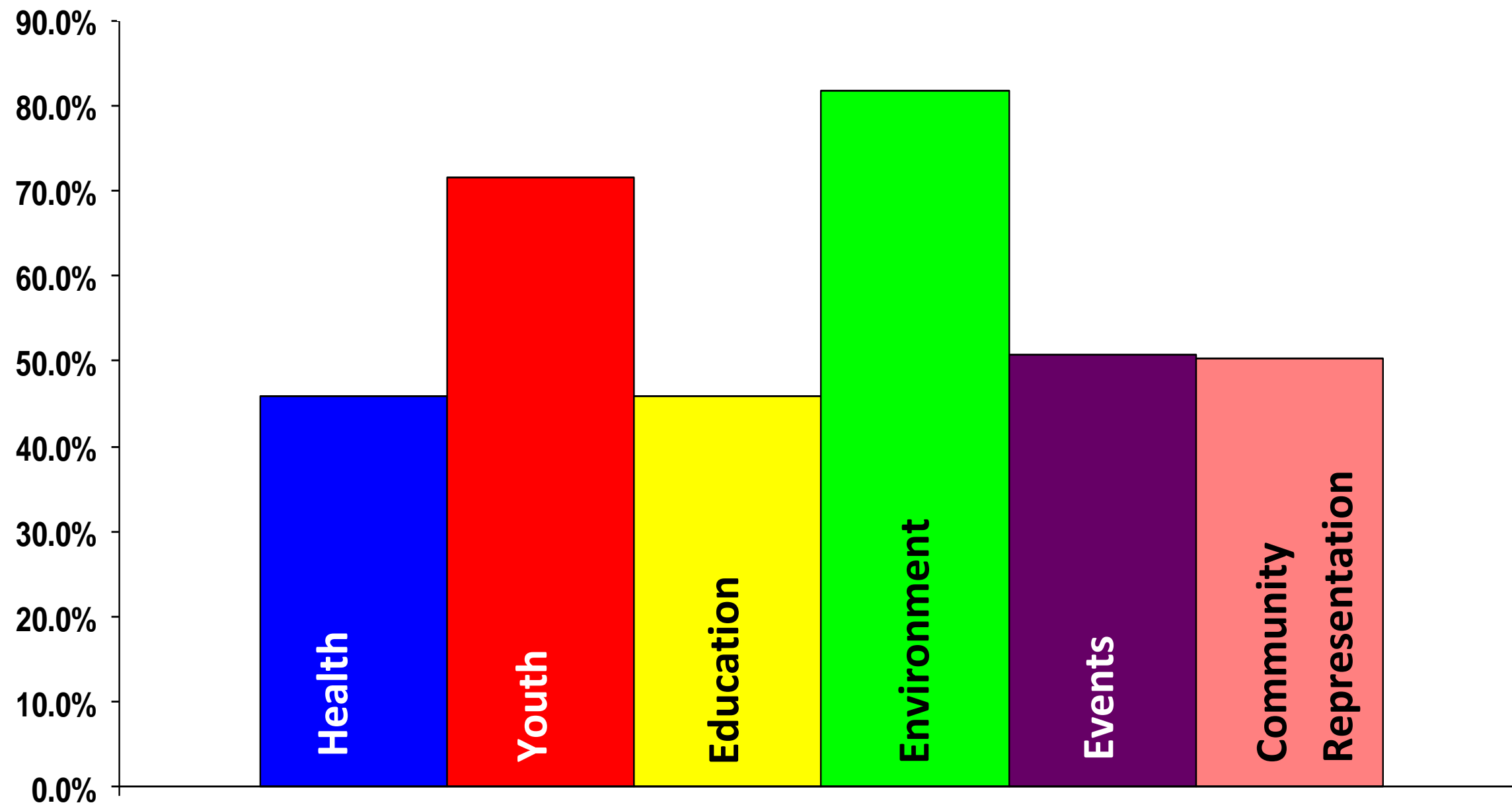


# In 2006/7 you told us your priorities were....



# 2006/7 – Examples of what we did

Organised the first annual health event for Handsworth.  
Ran weekly exercise classes & started a new line dancing group.

Organised the Handsworth Gala Day & Community Safety Day  
Advertised new community car boot sales  
Ran the annual Christmas Carol Concert

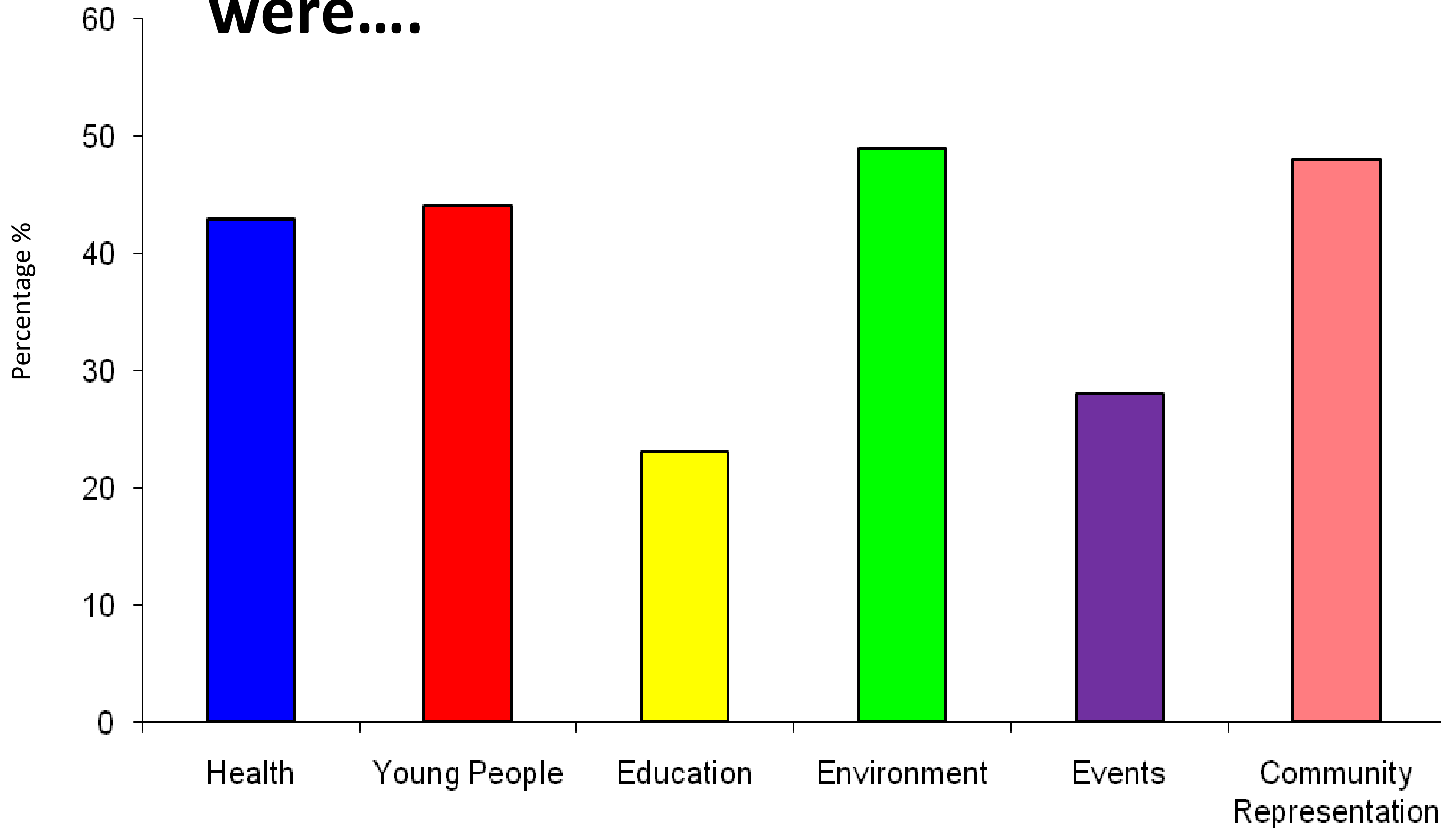
Organised weekly adult learning classes each academic term  
Rasied funds to develop our own ICT learning suite.  
Employed Community Learning Champions to increase awareness of education.

Worked with city council to reduce traffic congestion on Handsworth Road through reinforcing 30mph limits and installing the new urban clear way system.  
Lobbied for a replacement lollypop attendant for a school crossing.  
Made the police a standing agenda item at our public meetings.

Employed our own youth worker to engage young people  
Organised new holiday activity camps for 8-16's..  
Set up an evening sports club.  
Hosted work placement students from Handsworth Grange School.  
Worked with Police to put a Section 30 order in Handsworth to stop youth nuisance and move on trouble makers.  
Set up new sports clubs (climbing, trampolining & street dance).

Worked with city council to address dog fouling (new signs and patrols).  
Worked with the local schools to plant trees on the new park.  
Helped raise awareness of litter problems around schools.  
Organised bulb/flower planting in visible areas and installed 7 street planters along Handsworth Road.  
Organised public meetings and raised grant funding to improve Handsworth Community Park .

Maintained the annual health event adding more services.

Raised funding to expand the OAP lunch club

Continued the regular Get Active holiday activity camps for 8-16's

Set up a new motorcycle training initiative with Sheffield Futures to combat off-road biking.

Hosted work placement students from Handsworth Grange School.

Worked with partners to set up The South East Oscars – an event to celebrate the positive achievements of young people.

Continued running weekly adult learning classes and expanded the range of courses on offer.

Extended the hours and contract of our Community Learning Champion.

Introduced discounted community day trips to various destinations

Ran the annual Christmas Carol Concert

Maintained close working with the Police and City Council and attended key meetings affecting service delivery in our area

Continue to run monthly public meetings addressing issues of concern within the community

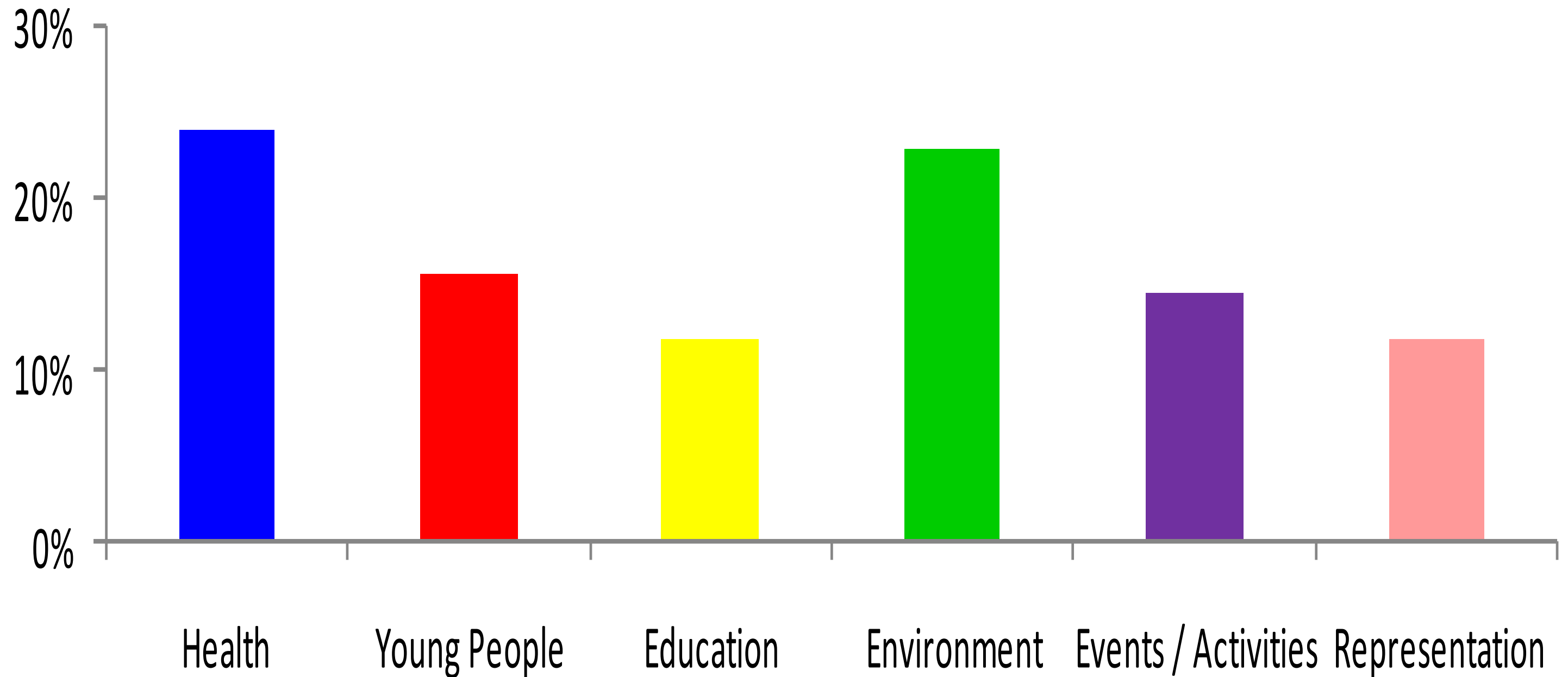
Continue to distribute the quarterly newsletter to every household in Handsworth

# 2010/11 – Examples of what we are doing

Continued running the annual health event adding more services.

Set up a new Indoor Bowling Activity for 50yrs +

Continued to support the running of the Friday morning Aerobics class for 50yrs+

Invite GP surgeries to present service overview at a public meeting

Expanded our range and frequency of coach trip destinations

Increased promotion of other groups summer fayres

Christmas Carol Concert to be expanded

Planning a new Handsworth Forum Centenary event.

Maintained close working with the Police and City Council and attended key meetings affecting service delivery in our area

Continue to run monthly public meetings addressing issues of concern within the community

Continue to distribute the quarterly newsletter to every household in Handsworth

Continued the regular Get Active holiday activity camps for 8-16's for 9 weeks in the year.

Hosted work placement students from Handsworth Grange School to help with community projects.

Supported the development of school tri-golf training sessions and summer tournament.

Helped advertise and promote the activities of other providers in the area.

Raised funding to employ a Community Park Warden.

Raised £3000 for new pathways, flowers and shrubs on the park.

Worked with St Joseph's School to plant flower beds in the park.

Installed new railing planters along Handsworth Road and continued to maintain the 7 street planters.

To continue plantings seasonal bulbs in visible places.

Continued running weekly adult learning classes and ask residents for more input into when/where/what we offer.

To raise funding to extend the hours and contract of our Community Learning Champion.
